

DigiVET Multiplier event report (Project Number: 2018-1-DE02-KA202-005145)

Due to the COVID19 global pandemic this Erasmus Plus project was delayed and the German NA granted an extension till 31 May 2021. This was to allow dissemination, final activities plus final project meeting to take place so that the project could be completed successfully.

In UK however, due to lockdown rules both during 2020 and also the beginning of 2021 dissemination activities via F2F meetings were not possible. F2F meeting with Covid precautions were explored by the UK team but the costs of setting up such meeting was prohibitive due to high costs and limited budget allocated for such activities. Therefore, the team in UK relied on online dissemination via zoom. The event was successful as 48 participants joined the multiplier event.

During the multiplier zoom meeting on 15 May 2021, ARVET shared the project's objectives and the results achieved during the project. Participants seemed very keen to try our sMOOCs and links to the website and sMOOCs were provided to all participants during the meeting.


